REQUIREMENTS:

Complete at least one project of kindness, and then write an essay about how your project(s) has/have made a positive impact in your community. Your essay <u>must</u> meet the following parameters:

- 1. Be between 500 and 1,000 words.
- 2. Answer the following two questions:
 - a. How have you made a ripple to change the world in your community?
 - b. How did your ripple impact you and others?
- 3. Your submission is limited to 3 pages: Page 1 Cover Page, Page 2 Essay, and Page 3 Up to 3 photos of your kindness project.
- 4. E-mail your submission to Meredith Webster at scholarships@givesevendays.org with the subject line "SevenDays Make a Ripple Scholarship."

Your essay **should** discuss include the following information: (1) when you did your project, (2) who was involved, (3) where you did your project, and (4) why you chose this event or project. **ESSAYS ARE DUE MARCH 1, 2019.**

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT: Five scholarships will be given to graduating high school seniors for higher education tuition in the amount of \$1,000 each.

Winners will be informed via phone or e-mail the week of March 25th, 2019. Winners will be recognized and awarded their scholarships at the ceremony on April 9, 2019. Mark your calendars now!
